The first "big" transport to Theresienstadt out of Berlin ran with the State Railways number "Da 502". Unlike the "small" transports in single cars hitherto leaving Berlin from the Anhalter Station, the passenger cars of this transport were loaded with the people to be deported at Berlin-Moabit freight station. On arrival at Theresienstadt the transport was designated as "I/46". It carried at least 165 inhabitants of the old-age home on Gerlachstrasse 18-21. Already in September and October 1942, 377 persons from this transport were shipped to Treblinka. In January 1943, 5 of its deportees reached Auschwitz and during 1944, another 19. We know of 16 survivors from this transport.
