The designation given in Theresienstadt to the people arriving in two reserved cars from Berlin, Anhalter Station, was "I/50", which means that 50 transports had already left the capital of the Reich for Bohemia since 2<sup>nd</sup> June 1942. The RSHA had originally - after the two transports from Cologne of the 15<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup> July 1942 - applied for a third special train for 1000 persons from Cologne-Falk to Theresienstadt, and this had been assigned the number "Da 526" for the schedules program of the 8<sup>th</sup> August 1942. However this journey was soon cancelled again by the Gestapo.
